Our Lord came as Emmanuel, God with us. Those around saw His humanity when they looked at Him; they saw His deity in His miracles. They trusted Him when He promised light to those who follow Him in this dark world. He gives the ability to walk after Him in new life, and we see how to walk in His light, leaving death and entering into His life.

It seems like walking has taken up much of my time in the past few months. Two surgeries and much exercising have taken a lot longer than the healing command to the lame man from my Savior to walk, but He has been at work in my life. I thank God every day for something as basic as standing and walking without assistance.

The country of Haiti has been wandering down dark paths this year. Political upheaval, corruption, gangs and violence have left the country in pain and without definite direction. There are rumors of major new disturbances planned for January 1, Haiti's Independence Day. Haiti needs to be healed by God.

Praise God gave safety during more than four thousand miles of travel in the past three months, along with a lot of walking during visits to churches.

Because of faithful supporters, the needs for my workers and the clinic have been met for the end of this year and through March of next year.

Prayer Please pray for Christians as they go through this violent time that they would be faithful witnesses for their Lord, and that they would have their needs met.

When things are unsettled in Haiti, voodoo activity becomes more open and worshippers much bolder. Please pray that the bright light of the Gospel will shine in this dark country as Christians have opportunities to share it with those around them.

Please pray that I will have wisdom about when to return to Haiti, and what I should be doing in the meantime.

Jesus Christ came as the light of the world, and walked among us giving life and healing to soul and body. He then died for our sins and rose from the dead, giving tangible evidence that His disciples would live with Him forever. May we walk worthy of our Lord so that those around us see the Savior Who walks with us, and want to follow Him out of the kingdom of darkness to walk in His life and light.
